

We have 12 slips reserved at the Port Orchard Marina but you will have to call and make your own reservations. Be sure to tell them you are with TTPYC. The minimum moorage cost in \$40.00 and is for boats 40ft and under. Each additional foot of boat length adds a dollar to the moorage cost. Electricity is \$4.00. The reserved slips are on the end of the dock near the party tent - slips 1-12.

Smart phones may look slightly different depending on the phone type, but the concept is the same. I would also encourage you to explore the site. You may get lost (sometimes I do) but it's a good way to learn what is there. Ready, set, POST!


