Racing News

December saw the start of the Southern Sound Series races with Winter Vashon. The course is clockwise around Vashon Island with the start and finish in front of the Tacoma Yacht Club. The race consisted of little wind and strong currents.

Several of the starts were postponed to allow the preceding classes to clear the start line as they were moving so slowly. A few boats got caught by the flood tide that was causing a westerly current and were over the start line early. It took them a LONG time to get back to re-start.

Most of the race consisted of chasing small zephyrs of "wind", but mostly letting the current push the boats north up Colvos Passage. By mid-day the flood tide switched to ebb which accelerated the northward flush. Lots of boats abandoned the race as it was becoming apparent there was little chance of completing the race within the time limit, even with it being shortened at the north end of the island. We kept racing on Equus as the rain had quit, the sun had come out and it was a warm, pleasant afternoon. It would take a miracle for anyone to finish.

Shortly before dark a miracle arrived with enough wind to allow the fleet to actually sail towards the finish. Unfortunately, the wind Gods can be cruel as the

wind shut off and on several times. As we approached the finish line the wind quit and the current pushed us past the line, missing it by 50 feet. We were not the only ones to receive a Did Not Finish by missing the line. It appears the only TTPYC club boat to finish was Nimbus (but the results page is suspect). That's racing, but we were still glad to be out on the water.

January brings the TTPYC sponsored SSS race, Duwamish Head. Gordon Kells-Murphy (sailsman@earthlink.net) is in charge of organizing our volunteers' group. Our needs start Friday afternoon January 10th with helping the incoming fleet dock in guest moorage. We also supply food and drinks to the arriving participants. Saturday morning food and coffee is available from our friends at Quarter Deck bistro at the head of the fuel dock. The actual running of the race requires significant help so contact Gordon if you are available. Come out and cheer on the fleet, it's always a fun spectacle!
